



APPRENTICESHIPS

APPRENTICESHIPS ARE WHEN YOU WORK FOR 80% OF THE WEEK AND GO TO YOUR TRAINING PROVIDER FOR 20% OF THE WEEK. APPRENTICES HAVE ALL THE SAME RIGHTS AS OTHER MEMBERS OF STAFF.



ENTRY-LEVEL JOBS

THIS MEANS YOU ARE LEAVING EDUCATION AND GOING INTO A "NORMAL" JOB. THERE ARE NO FORMAL QUALIFICATIONS THAT YOU RECEIVE, BUT YOU MAY HAVE THE OPPORTUNITY TO TAKE PART IN TRAINING OFFERED BY THE EMPLOYER.




GAP YEARS
